Principal's Report

This week our school celebrated Numeracy Week and National eSmart Week.

Cairnlea Park is an eSmart school and values the commitment to raise digital citizens who know how to be smart, safe and responsible both on and offline. This week students have participated in a range of activities designed to address cyber safety, wellbeing and digital inclusion. A display of our students' commitment to becoming a cyber safety community is in the library, and parents are welcome to pop in before or after school to take a look at the display. We have also included in this week's newsletter some information for parents about parenting in the digital age.

As part of our Numeracy Week celebrations students across the school participated in STEM (learning of science, technology, engineering and mathematics in an integrated approach) learning tasks encouraging students to be problem solvers, innovators and critical thinkers. Some of the tasks included making a bridge, constructing a marble run and designing a logo.

2018 NAPLAN

Results for the NAPLAN tests that were undertaken by our Year 3 and 5 students in May this year, were mailed out to all parents on Friday 31st August. NAPLAN is a measure at one point in time of how students are performing in numeracy, reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation.

Parents please file your child's NAPLAN report away, as many secondary schools are now requesting a copy as part of your child's enrolment. If you wish to discuss your child's NAPLAN results, please call the office to arrange an appointment with the class teacher.
