## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Welcome back to all our families for Term 3. This week has been planning week for the staff preparing for the term ahead. The Semester 2 timetable will be up and running for the beginning of next week.

The beginning of the term will see some staffing additions. Ms Azzopardi has returned for 2 days a week working in the Grade 4 area. Ms Verdolini takes up the fulltime LOTE Italian position. We are also in the process of appointing another new ES integration aide to begin as soon as possible.

Over the holidays we continued with our maintenance program around the school. We upgraded the line marking to our outside courts and to our fun areas outside the prep rooms in the canteen area. Plumbers were in and cleared all the guttering. Electricians and Powercor were in to upgrade the school's electrical capacity to cope with the power demand when all heating and cooling systems are working overtime on extreme weather days. This should now stop the major power outage that we had at the end of last term.

Please see the Department of Health [website](#) for the latest face mask requirements as advice may change at short notice.

Work

- Face masks are mandatory indoors (not at home) for anyone aged 12 and above, unless an exception applies.

Schools

- School staff and secondary school students aged 12 or older must carry a face mask at all times and wear a face mask indoors when at school, including when attending an Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) program, unless a lawful exception applies. Face masks must be worn outdoors where physical distancing of 1.5m cannot be maintained.
- Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OSHC program.

- Face masks are mandatory for all school staff and school students aged 12 or older on public transport and when in taxis or ride share vehicles. This includes travelling to and from school on public transport or in a vehicle with others not from your household.
- For the purpose of communication, teachers and education support staff are not required to wear face masks while teaching, but those who wish to do so, can.
- Visitors and parents must also observe face mask requirements

### **Yard Supervision**

Parents please be aware of these supervision times to ensure the safety of your children as much as possible. The school grounds are supervised from 8.35am until 8.55am in the morning and from 3.20pm until 3.35pm in the afternoon.

Children must not arrive before 8.35am and must leave the school grounds by 3.35pm.

The Out of School Hours Care program provides a safe and secure service for working parents who need to drop their children off at school early or have them cared for after school. Enrolment forms are available at the office or by calling Camp Australia on 0423795208.

### **2022 Prep Enrolments**

Prep enrolments for next year are now being taken. Children must celebrate their fifth birthday by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2022 to be eligible for school. Due to our enrolment restrictions, we are unable to accept prep enrolments from families who live outside the Cairnlea estate. Parents are required to supply the following information when enrolling:

- Proof of residence in Cairnlea
- Proof of age (birth certificate or passport)
- Immunisation certificate

The next school tour will be on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July. Dates and times for future tours are on the school website and available through the office. Bookings through the office are essential for school tours.
