#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Well, the good news is we have all students back at school, and all remote learning has finished. Our grade 4 and grade 6 camps are still going ahead later this year.

Unfortunately following the Department of Education and Training covid guidance, there remains restrictions on access to the school site for anyone other than immediate school staff and students. Until further notice parents cannot come onsite into the school yard. All school assemblies are also cancelled. Hopefully these restrictions will be revisited by the government in 2 weeks

#### Please note the following important information.

- If your child is ill or is feeling unwell, they must not attend school. They must remain home and seek medical advice.
- The school canteen is open for normal sales.
- Any visitors to the office must wear a face mask and sign in or register using the QR code displayed.

#### Morning Drop off at school

- All entry gates will be manned by a teacher and will be opened at 8:35am. Students are to go directly to their classroom.
- Prep students and their older siblings in grade 1 to 6 are to enter through the front gates on Carmody Drive.
- Grade 1 students and their older siblings in grade 2 to 6 are to enter from the south gate on Shepperd Way (Near grade 1 and 2 classrooms).
- Grade 2 students and their older siblings in grade 3 to 6 are to enter from Shepperd Way near the school gym.
- Grade 3 and 4 students and their older siblings in grades 5 and 6 are to enter from the 2<sup>nd</sup> western entry on Shepperd Way near the Grade 6 portable classrooms.
- All other Grade 5 and 6 students are to enter from the oval gate on Furlong Rd.

#### Afternoon Pick up arrangements

- At afternoon pick up, all gates will be manned by a teacher.
- The eldest sibling needs to go to the youngest sibling's grade and then leave from the younger sibling's gate.
- Students must exit from their allocated gates escorted by their classroom teacher.

#### Information on the wearing of face masks at school

There has been no change to the face mask advice, which will continue to apply to all school settings, including any OSHC programs:

- School staff and secondary school students aged 12 or older must wear a face mask at all times indoors and outdoors when at school, including when attending an OSHC program, unless a lawful exception applies.
- Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OSHC program.
- Face masks are mandatory for all school staff and school students aged 12 or older on public transport and when in taxis or ride-share vehicles. This includes travelling to and from school on public transport or in a vehicle with others not from your household.
- For the purpose of communication, teachers and education support staff are not required to wear face masks while teaching, but those who wish to do so, can.

Please see the Department of Health <u>website</u> for the latest face mask requirements as advice may change at short notice.

#### **2022 Prep Enrolments**

Prep enrolments for next year are now being taken. Children must celebrate their fifth birthday by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2022 to be eligible for school. Due to our enrolment restrictions, we are unable to accept prep enrolments from families who live outside the Cairnlea estate. Parents are required to supply the following information when enrolling:

- Proof of residence in Cairnlea
- Proof of age (birth certificate or passport)
- Immunisation certificate

School tours at the moment have been postponed. Dates and times for future tours will be posted on the school website when we are allowed to conduct tours.
